

Appendix 1 – Admission Guidelines

<p>Entry Arrangements</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Attendees may reach their designated gates via West Bridge (near MTR Sung Wong Toi Station) or Central Square (near MTR Kai Tak Station). • For tickets marked Gate Y, please note that the walking route differs from other gates. From Kai Tak Station Exit D, follow the on-site directional signs and traffic guidance through Station Square and the Muk Tai Street roundabout, then proceed across the Shing Kai Road pedestrian crossing to reach Gate Y. • Once a ticket has been scanned for entry, re-entry is not permitted. • Please note all venue rules and item restrictions. Items not permitted inside include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➢ Plastic/silicone bottles or cups larger than 600 ml ➢ Bottles/cups under 600 ml with caps/lids or containing any liquid ➢ Cameras, tablets, any cheering props larger than 38 cm x 30 cm x 20 cm, and long umbrellas • Depending on weather conditions, attendees are encouraged to dress comfortably. • On rainy days, please allow extra time for security checks. Long umbrellas are strictly prohibited inside the venue.
<p>Ticketing Arrangements</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Attendees should collect their physical tickets prior to event day at HK Ticketing’s self-service ticket collection kiosks located across Hong Kong, Kowloon, the New Territories, Guangzhou and Shenzhen. • Location of HK Ticketing self-service ticket collection kiosks: https://hkt.hkticketing.com/en/#/news/detail/0/4 • Those collecting physical tickets on the concert day at Kai Tak Sports Park must arrive early and allow sufficient time for ticket collection and entry.
<p>Transportation Arrangements</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Public transport is recommended for both arrival and departure. • Cross-boundary travellers please note the service hours of the MTR Tuen Ma Line, the last trains from Sung Wong Toi

Station and Kai Tak Station to Lo Wu Station on the East Rail Line (exchange via Tai Wai Station) will depart at 10:59pm and 11:01pm respectively.

- **Special bus and cross-boundary bus routes services:** A total of 11 special bus routes will be available after the event at the Sung Wong Toi Road PUDO Area, going to Lok Ma Chau (San Tin) Public Transport Interchange (for transfer to Shenzhen via Yellow Bus) – Route SP12, Hong Kong-Zhuhai-Macao Bridge Hong Kong Port / Airport (to Macau/Zhuhai via Golden Bus shuttles) – Route A25S, and major areas on Hong Kong Island, Kowloon and the New Territories.
- **Cross-boundary coaches services:** Available at the Stadium’s coach bus pick-up and drop-off area on the ground floor. Passengers can board the coaches from this area by taking the escalator down outside Gate H on Level 2 of the Stadium. Please allow time to collect your stored luggage and note the boarding location and schedule, including the departure time of the last bus, to avoid missing the service and affecting return arrangements.
- For spectators using **taxi services:** Taxi drop-off at (1) Kai Tak Stadium, and (2) Kai Tak Arena (no pick-up). After the event, please note that Kai Tak Stadium Taxi PUDO Area will be open.
- **Private car** users may drop off passengers at the designated drop-off point at Kai Tak Youth Sports Ground (drop-off between 4pm to 6pm) or at designated pick-up and drop-off points on Muk Wo Street in Kai Tak, and Ma Tau Kok Road in To Kwa Wan. Please do not drop-off or pick-up passengers on Shing Kai Road, as this area is a 24-hour no-parking zone.
- **The Car Park at Kai Tak Stadium and Kai Tak Arena** is only available for those who have made a reservation or purchased a parking voucher. The entry time for private car parking voucher at the Kai Tak Stadium is from 7am to 11:59pm on the same day, and registered vehicles may enter and exit multiple times. The 4-hour private car parking voucher for the Kai Tak Arena allows parking from 7am to 11:59pm on the same day, applicable for a single entry and exit from the Arena parking lot, with a limit of 4 hours per parking session. - Individuals with special needs (such as those using rehabilitation buses) who wish to attend the event at the Stadium, please call the KTSP Special Service Hotline (Tel: 6182 7494) to register and make a reservation. The Park will

Baggage Storage	<p><u>Paid Item Storage</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Paid storage facilities will be available near the Stadium for event participants. Opening hours from 1pm to 10:30pm. • Users must take their luggage to the following storage locations on the day of the event: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Kai Tak Arena 1M level (near the Central Square) 2. Outside Kai Tak Youth Sports Ground 3. Kai Tak Stadium Gate Y <p><u>Electronic Lockers</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Lockers are available at Kai Tak Mall 1 (1/F), Kai Tak Mall 2 (3/F) and Kai Tak Mall 3 (2/F), as well as in the drop-off area of the Kai Tak Arena, with different sizes for visitors to temporarily store personal belongings as needed. Visitors can use the navigation feature of the Kai Tak Sports Park mobile app to find the location of the lockers. • For more details, please refer to the link.
Official Merchandise	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The official merchandise sales locations will be set up at Central Square. • Only credit card or mobile payment will be accepted. • Please bring your own shopping bags.
Smoking Regulations	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Smoking is strictly prohibited throughout Kai Tak Sports Park (except in designated smoking areas). • During the event, outdoor temporary designated smoking areas are available outside the Stadium. Spectators may visit the smoking area before entering or after leaving the venue. • Please note that once a ticket has been scanned for entry, it cannot be used for re-entry.
