

ANNEX I: Event Guides

Entry Arrangements	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All Gates can be accessed via either West Bridge (closest MTR Sung Wong Toi Station) or Central Square (closest MTR Kai Tak station). • If your ticket states “Gate X”, please note that the walking route to Gate X differs from other gates. Gate X is on the ground level. Follow on-site signage and approach Gate X via Shing Kai Road Park. • Re-entry is not allowed once a ticket is scanned for entry. • Comply with venue regulations and take note of all restricted items. Plastic/silicon water bottles not over 600ml must come without lids and liquid; photography equipment, tablets, cheering materials larger than 38cm x 30cm x 20cm and long umbrellas are not permitted inside the Stadium. • To prepare for rainy weather, spectators are advised to dress lightly. • If it rains on the day of the event, please allow extra time for security checks and remember that long umbrellas are not permitted inside the Stadium.
Ticket Collection	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Attendees are advised to pick up their physical tickets in advance at designated Cityline locations before the event day. These locations include various spots in Hong Kong, Kowloon and the New Territories, Guangzhou, Shenzhen, Zhuhai, and Macau, totalling over 40 self-service stations. • If attendees need to pick up their physical tickets at Kai Tak Sports Park on the day of the event, please ensure ample time for ticket pick up and entry.
Transport Guide	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Public transport is recommended for both arrival and departure. • Cross-boundary travellers please note the service hours of the MTR Tuen Ma Line, the last trains from Sung Wong Toi Station and Kai Tak Station to Lo Wu Station on the East Rail Line (exchange via Tai Wai Station) will depart at 10:59 pm and 11:01 pm respectively. Passengers who are unable to catch the last train to Lo Wu Station can go to Sheung Shui Station on the East Rail Line (via Tai Wai Station) and transfer to bus routes 276B or N73 to Lok Ma Chau (San Tin) Public Transport Interchange, and then take the Lok Ma Chau – Huanggang cross-boundary shuttle buses (Yellow Bus) to Mainland China. • Special bus and cross-boundary bus routes services: A total of 11 special bus routes will be available after the event at the Sung

	<p>Wong Toi Road PUDO Area, including (i) Lok Ma Chau (San Tin) Public Transport Interchange (for transfer to Shenzhen via Yellow Bus) – Route SP12 and (ii) Hong Kong-Zhuhai-Macao Bridge Hong Kong Port / Airport (to Macau/Zhuhai via Golden Bus shuttles) – Route A25S, and major areas on Hong Kong Island, Kowloon and the New Territories.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cross-boundary coaches services to Lok Ma Chau / Huanggang: Available at the Stadium’s coach bus pick-up and drop-off area on the ground floor. Passengers can board the coaches from this area by taking the escalator down outside Gate H on Level 2 of the Stadium. • Passengers using the cross-boundary coach services departing from Kai Tak Sports Park are advised to note the boarding location and schedule, including the departure time of the last bus, to avoid missing the service and affecting return arrangements. • For spectators using taxi services: Taxi drop-off at (i) Kai Tak Stadium, (ii) Kai Tak Arena (no pick-up), and (iii) Sung Wong Toi Road PUDO Area will be open for taxi drop-off only from 2 pm to 6:30 pm (no pick-up). After the event, please note that Kai Tak Stadium Taxi PUDO Area will be open. • Private car users may drop off passengers at the designated drop-off point at Kai Tak Youth Sports Ground (drop-off between 2 pm and 6:30 pm) or at designated pick-up and drop-off points on Muk Wo Street in Kai Tak, and Ma Tau Kok Road in To Kwa Wan. • Kai Tak Arena Car Park will open some parking spaces from 2 pm for those who have purchased the parking voucher in advance. For more details, please visit the link. • Individuals with special needs (such as those using rehabilitation buses) who wish to attend the event at the Stadium, please call the KTSP Special Service Hotline (Tel: 6182 7494) to register and make a reservation. The Park will arrange staff to follow up and coordinate services and arrangements for the day.
Baggage Storage	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Paid storage facilities will be available near the Stadium for event participants. The service will be open from 1 pm to 11 pm on the day of the event. • Users are required to carry their own luggage/items to the designated storage counters and complete the process at Kai Tak Arena 1M level (near the Central Square), outside Kai Tak Youth Sports Ground (near the security checkpoint), and at the Kai Tak Arena cross-boundary shuttle bus pick-up and drop-off area.

Official Merchandise	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The organiser has set up the “CARAT ZONE” at East Village, where pre-registered ticket holders can redeem official gifts during the event. • The official merchandise sales points will be set up by the event organiser on (i) Level 2 of the Stadium at the Celebration Hall, and (ii) Central Square. • Members of the public can purchase official merchandise at the Dining Cove. • Only credit card or mobile payment will be accepted.
No Smoking	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Smoking is strictly prohibited throughout Kai Tak Sports Park (except in designated smoking areas). • During the event, outdoor temporary designated smoking areas are available outside the Stadium. Spectators may visit the smoking area before entering or after leaving the venue. • Please note that once a ticket has been scanned for entry, it cannot be used for re-entry.
